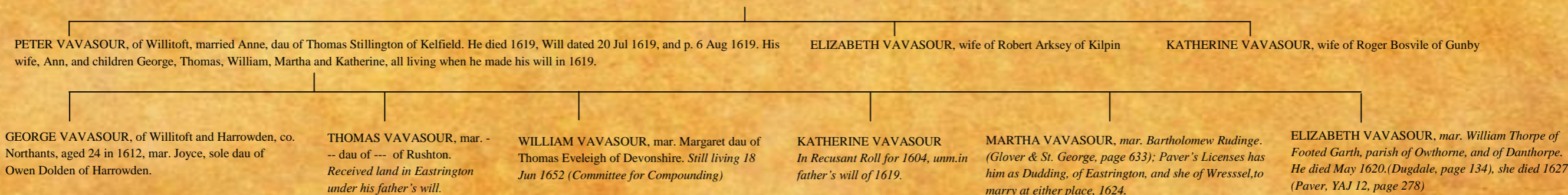


Vavasour of Willitoft in the Parish of Bubwith, in the East Riding of Yorkshire

A continuation of the **Pedigree of Vavasour, of Haslewood, Spaldington, Weston, Copmanthorpe, etc.** in Volume II of Joseph Foster's *Pedigrees of Yorkshire Families*, 1874, where the full pedigree of the Vavasours of Willitoft is wanting.

GEORGE VAVASOUR, 2nd son of Sir Peter Vavasour of Spaldington, Knt, by his wife Elizabeth, dau of Andrew, Lord Windsor of Standwell. He married Anna, dau and heiress of Robert Skipwith of Willitoft, and acquired *j.u.* the Willitoft estate. He died 23 June 1561.



The Pedigree in Foster's ends here, although it does name four children of George, namely: John, Robert, Ann and Mary. However, this can now be expanded upon, and the pedigree further developed (*italics above indicates extra notes added to Foster*).

Note: As the normal age range of students admitted to Douay was 12-15 years, it is probable that George, Thomas and (to a lesser extent) Philip were all born of Elizabeth Saltmarshe, i.e. no children were born of Peter's 2nd wife Elizabeth, with maybe the exception of Philip, who if he joined Douay at age 12, was born 1716.
